Introduction

Valiathope Our Lady of Good Death Vincent de Paul Society which began on 5th of November 2017, has crossed 6 eventful years and is joyfully entering the 7th year. The relentless efforts of our previous Parish Priest, Fr. Cyrus Kalathil and Sr. Salomi are behind the inception of this Society in Thope.

We truly believe that it's only by the will and grace of God that we are able to provide help and service to hundreds of families, several old age homes and orphanages and many sick and needy. A much needed helping hand was rendered to those who lost their homes in the sea erosion and those affected by the Covid Pandemic. It's with much joy we can say that these services were done during the last 5 years to the needy irrespective of caste, creed or religion.

Even during the last year ie 2023 we could continue our assistance and help to several families and we surrender with gratitude to our Lord for His guidance. Including the 6.76 lakhs of the year of reporting, almost 45.56 lakhs was utilized for to welfare of the poor and needy. In addition to this we could also help many institutions and deserving persons.

Sessions and Visits

We conducted 43 sessions during the report year and had 10 visits to old age homes and orphanages.

New Members

We gladly welcomed 3 new members to our society and thus expanding it. Unfortunately 1 person left.

Important Works

Adopting Families

One of the significant missions of Vincent de Paul Society is to adopt few families and provide assistance on a regular basis and also help them to tide over any unforeseen crisis.

Assisting Old Age Homes and Orphanages

From the inception of this organization, it was decided by our conference to pay monthly visits to orphanages, old age homes, schools housing poor children, institutions having mentally and physically challenged persons and those institutions providing treatment for the same. This agenda was carried out diligently and 11 such visits were made during the report year.

Education

7 students were assisted with their school/college fees and their hostel fees which came upto Rs 52,795.

Education Scholarship

9 students upto class +2, belonging to families of Thope Parish who lost their homes and belongings in the sea erosion, were given a monthly scholarship of Rs 1500. We are very

grateful to the overseas Vincent de Paul members and Trivandrum Central Council leaders for their overwhelming support for this cause.

Medicines

Very poor patients of Thope Parish, irrespective of caste, creed, or religion who cannot afford to meet their medical

expences, were supplied with medicine and treatment. Rs 68,787 was spent for this cause. Besides this, medicines were made available for many cancer patients through the Trivandrum Corporation.



House Renovation

2 houses worn down by time and tide, not fit to live in, were renovated and handed over to the families. Rs 21,000 was utilized for this purpose.

House Rent

For few families who lost their homes and land due to sea erosion, monthly house rent was provided through the diocese.

2 families are getting their monthly house rent of Rs 3000 from Theeradesha Matsyathozhilali Forum.

Marriage

2 girls belonging to very poor families were given Rs 10,000 to meet their wedding expenses.

C.C Old Age Home Building Fund

Under the leadership of the Central Council, a home for abandoned and destitute women is being planned. For this purpose each conference member has contributed Rs 10,000. Collection is being carried out from parishners and other kind hearted souls. Rs 25,000 collected so far has been submitted to the C.C. We are glad to handover a sum of Rs 1.75 lakhs along with this report for this noble cause.

Funeral

Rs 5000, was given to a family who was finding it difficult to meet the funeral and related expenses.

Others

A family where the parents are separated and have 2 children pursuing higher studies after +2, are being assisted with a sewing machine and motor so as to have their own income. Rs 8900 was spent on this.

Rs 5700 collected from our members was sent for our Manipur brethren , the sad victims of ethnic violence.

Formation of Youth Conference

The involvement of our youth in social and community service has declined these days. To bring the youth under one umbrella and to cultivate a sense of service to society and thereby experiencing and sharing God's message of love through charity, a Youth Conference was formed in Thope Parish. This year the Youth Conference of Vincent de Paul Society is celebrating their first anniversary. We are supporting and guiding these God send youngsters in their work so that they can be an inspiration and example for the youth in and around our parish.



Christmas Kit Distribution

Christmas and New Year is a season of hope, peace, joy and love. Vincent de Paul Society selects the families who are not able to celebrate these occasions because of poverty or other issues. Christmas kits are delivered to these families on Christmas Eve, so that they too can have a dignified celebration along with us. This year kits were delivered to 72 families irrespective of their religion and creed. Most of the families were from the neighbouring villages. Rs 82,040 was spent for this. Apart from this, Rs 4820 was given by Valiyathura Forane Matsya Sushrusa Committee for provision and groceries.



Masses

Masses were celebrated on 9th of September, Feast of Frederick Osanam, on 27th of September, Feast of Vincent de Paul and on 8th of December, Feast of Solemnity of Immaculate Conception.

Area Council Meeting

Meetings conducted by Valiyathura Area Council are regularly attended and we pursue the advice and directions suggested by them.

Well Wishers

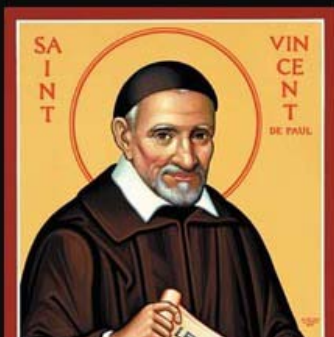
